John 11:33~ Jesus, therefore, when he saw her weeping, and the Jews that came with her weeping, groaned in the spirit, and became troubled.

1• Jesus then, when he saw her, and all the comforters there with her, groaned within his spirit, and became troubled.

[Question] How did Jesus now come to feel, upon seeing so many there, mourning over the death of Lazarus?

2. After saying these things, Jesus became troubled in spirit, and he bore witness and said; Most truly I say to you, one of you will betray me. (John 13:21)

[Question] What did Jesus show on another occasion, when he knew one of his disciples was about to betray him, showing that he too had deep personal feelings for others?

3 And with a look up into heaven he sighed deeply and said to him; *Ephphatha*, that is, **Be opened**. (Mark 7:34)

[Question] What did Jesus express when healing a man?

4. And when the Lord caught sight of her, he was moved with pity for her, and he said to her; Stop weeping. (Luke 7:13)

[Question] How did Jesus feel, when he saw a widow with her onlybegotten son dead and being carried out to be buried?
