

**John 11:33~** Jesus, therefore, when he saw her weeping, and the Jews that came with her weeping, groaned in the spirit, and became troubled.

- 1· Jesus then, when he saw her, and all the comforters there with her, groaned within his spirit, and became troubled.

**[Question]** How did Jesus now come to feel, upon seeing so many there, mourning over the death of Lazarus?

- 2· After saying these things, Jesus became troubled in spirit, and he bore witness and said; Most truly I say to you, one of you will betray me. (**John 13:21**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus show on another occasion, when he knew one of his disciples was about to betray him, showing that he too had deep personal feelings for others?

- 3· And with a look up into heaven he sighed deeply and said to him; *Ephphatha*, that is, **Be opened**. (**Mark 7:34**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus express when healing a man?

- 4· And when the Lord caught sight of her, he was moved with pity for her, and he said to her; Stop weeping. (**Luke 7:13**)

**[Question]** How did Jesus feel, when he saw a widow with her only-begotten son dead and being carried out to be buried?
