

John 11:38~ Hence Jesus, after groaning again within himself, came to the memorial tomb. It was, in fact, a cave, and a stone was lying against it.

- 1· So Jesus after groaning within himself over their lack of faith, soon came to the burial site. It was a memorial tomb, a cave in the rock mass, and a large stone was lying against the opening.

[Question] How did Jesus then feel, over their lack of faith, in what he was about to do?

[Question] Where then, did they eventually come to, and what was in front of the memorial tomb?

- 2· When he got to the other side, into the country of the Gadarenes, there met him two demon-possessed men, coming out from among the **memorial tombs**, unusually fierce, so that, nobody had the courage to pass by on that road. (**Matthew 8:28**)

[Question] Where had Jesus encountered two demon possessed men, and where were they living in among?

- 3· Do not marvel at this, because the hour is coming in which all those in the **memorial tombs** will hear his voice. (**John 5:28**)

[Question] What hour did Jesus state was coming, and what then would occur?

- 4· And laid it in his new **memorial tomb**, which he had quarried in the rock-mass. And, **after** rolling a big **stone** to the door of the **memorial tomb**, he left. (**Matthew 27:60**)

[Question] Where was Jesus himself laid, when he died, and how was that tomb in the rocks made secure?

- 5· Accordingly he bought fine linen and took him down, wrapped him in the fine linen and laid him in a **tomb** which was quarried out of a rock-mass, and he rolled a **stone** up to the door of the **memorial tomb**. (**Mark 15:46**)

[Question] Where was Jesus himself laid when he died, and what was his tomb quarried out of?

- 6· And with a look up into heaven he sighed deeply and said

to him; *Ephphatha*, that is; **Be opened.** (Mark 7:34)

[Question] What then, did Jesus state, when healing a man who was deaf and dumb, and what does it mean?
