4. And laid it in his new memorial tomb, which he had quarried in the rock-mass. And, after rolling a big stone to the door of the memorial tomb, he left. (Matthew 27:60)

[Question] Where was Jesus himself laid, when he died, and how was that tomb in the rocks made secure?

5. Accordingly he bought fine linen and took him down, wrapped him in the fine linen and laid him in a tomb which was quarried out of a rock-mass, and he rolled a stone up to the door of the memorial tomb. (Mark 15:46)

[Question] Where was Jesus himself laid when he died, and what was his tomb quarried out of?

6. And with a look up into heaven he sighed deeply and said
