

**John 11:39~** Jesus said; **Take the stone away.** Martha, the sister of the deceased, said to him; Lord, by now he must smell, for it is four days.

**3· On the first day of the week Mary Magdalene came to the memorial tomb early, while there was still darkness, and she beheld the stone already taken away from the memorial tomb. (John 20:1)**

**[Question]** What did Mary Magdalene realize, upon arriving at the place where Jesus was buried?
