

John 11:40~ Jesus said to her; **Did I not tell you, that if you would believe, you would see the glory of God?**

- 1· However Jesus reminded Martha of what he had previously told her about her faith, and that if she would keep her faith, then she would see the very glory of God.

[Question] What then, did Jesus remind Martha that she needed to continue in?

- 2· Jesus answered; Neither this man sinned nor his parents, but it was, in order, that the works of God might be made manifest in his case. (**John 9:3**)

[Question] What had Jesus previously revealed, why some people had been born with defects and sicknesses?

- 3· And in the morning you will indeed **see** Yehowah's **glory**, because he has heard your murmurings against Yehowah. And what are we, that you should murmur against us? (**Exodus 16:7**)

[Question] How did Moses feel about the murmurings of the Israelites?

- 4· But Jesus, overhearing the word being spoken, **said** to the presiding officer of the synagogue; Have no fear, only exercise faith. (**Mark 5:36**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell Jarius to continue exercising, even though he received news, that his daughter had just died?

- 5· Jesus **said** to him; That expression; If you can! Why, all things can be to one if one has faith. (**Mark 9:23**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell them was possible for anyone having faith?

- 6· But Paul went downstairs, threw himself upon him, and embraced him, and **said**; Stop raising a clamor, for his soul is in him. (**Acts of Apostles 20:10**)

[Question] How did Paul feel, and what did he do, when a young boy fell from a window and died, while listening to one of Paul's discourses?
