John 11:41~ Therefore they took the stone away. Now Jesus raised his eyes heavenward and said; Father, I thank you that you have heard me.

1. So the men present rolled away the stone. Now Jesus raised his eyes to heaven and said; Father I thank you that you have heard me. This he said, because he had already asked God if he would do this for Lazarus, and he had been told that he would do it.

[Question] What did Jesus then say aloud to Yehowah God while the men rolled away the stone, for what had Yehowah God already told Jesus in spirit?

[Question] What confidence do anointed Christians have in Yehowah God, when doing his will?

5. Then he came in and closed the door behind them both and began to pray to Yehowah. (2 Kings 4:33)

[Question] Who did Elisha pray to, to resurrect a young boy who had died, and who did he bring with him into the room?

6. I shall laud you, for you answered me and you came to be my salvation. (Psalms 118:21)
