

John 11:42~ True, I knew that you always hear me, but on account of the crowd standing around I spoke, in order, that they might believe, that you sent me forth.

1· Jesus then told God, that he knew that God always heard him, no matter when or what he asked of him, but that on account of the crowd around him, he had spoken, in order, that they might believe, that Yehowah God had sent him forth.

[Question] What did Jesus then reveal, about how close Yehowah God and his son Jesus Christ were, but why had he said this aloud?

2· In answer Jesus said; This voice has occurred, not for my sake, but for your sakes. (**John 12:30**)

[Question] When Yehowah God spoke, what did Jesus state was the reason why?

3· In answer Jesus said to them; This is the work of God, that you exercise faith in him, whom that One **sent forth**. (**John 6:29**)

[Question] What is the work of Yehowah God?

4· Because the sayings that you gave me I have given to them, and they have received them, and have certainly come to know, that I came out as your representative, and they have believed that you **sent** me forth. (**John 17:8**)

[Question] Whose sayings did Jesus give to his disciples, and what did they come to believe about them?

5· And it came about at the time that the grain offering goes up, that Elijah the prophet began to approach and say; O Yehowah, the God of Abraham, Isaac and Israel, today let it be known, that you are God in Israel, and I am your servant, and it is by your word, that I have done all these things. (**1 Kings 18:36**)

[Question] What did Elijah ask Yehowah God to do to show that he alone was God in Israel?

6· However, I do not accept the witness from man, but I say these things that you may be saved. (**John 5:34**)

[Question] Whose witness did Jesus not accept?
