

John 11:43~ **And when he had said these things, he cried out with a loud voice; Lazarus,¹ come on out!**

1· So once he had said these things, he cried out with a loud voice, and said; Lazarus, come out!

[Question] What then, did Jesus say confidently, and with a loud voice?

2· With that he approached and touched the bier, and the bearers stood still, and he said; Young man, I say to you, get up! (Luke 7:14)

[Question] What did Jesus earlier say to a young man, being carried out to be buried?

3· You will call, and I myself shall answer you. For the work of your hands you will have a yearning. (Job 14:15)

[Question] What faith in the resurrection, did faithful Job exercise?

4· But he took her by the hand and called, saying; Girl, get up! (Luke 8:54)

[Question] What did Jesus do to resurrect the young girl, Jarius' daughter?

5· Most truly I say to you, the hour is coming, and it is now, when the dead will hear the voice of the Son of God, and those who have given heed will live. (John 5:25)

[Question] Whose voice, did Jesus state, that the dead would come to hear, resulting in what?

6· Accordingly Jesus, six days before the Passover, arrived at Bethany, where Lazarus was, whom Jesus had raised up from the dead. (John 12:1)

[Question] How long before the Passover was it, when Jesus made his final visit to Jerusalem?

7· Therefore, a great crowd of the Jews got to know he was there, and they came, not on account of Jesus only, but also to see Lazarus, whom he raised up from the dead. (John 12:9)

[Question] Who did many of the Jews in Jerusalem later want to see, because of this resurrection of Lazarus?

- 8· **Accordingly the crowd that was with him when he called Lazarus out of the memorial tomb, and raised him up from the dead, kept bearing witness. (John 12:17)**

[Question] Who bore witness to others on the day of Jesus' triumphal entry into Jerusalem?

- 9· **But Peter put everybody outside and, bending his knees, he prayed, and, turning to the body, he said; Tabitha, rise! She opened her eyes and, as she caught sight of Peter, she sat up. (Acts of Apostles 9:40)**

[Question] What did Peter later say, to resurrect Tabitha?
