

John 11:44~ The man that had been dead, came out with his feet and hands bound with wrappings, and his countenance was bound about with a cloth. Jesus said to them; **Loose him, and let him go.**

1· Then the man, that had been dead for four days, came out with his hands and feet bound with wrappings, and his face was bound with a cloth. Jesus then told the others to loose him, and let him go.

[Question] What then happened immediately, and how did Lazarus come out, for how long had he been buried?

[Question] What then, did Jesus tell his mourners to do for him?

2· And Joseph took the body, wrapped it up in clean fine linen. (**Matthew 27:59**)

[Question] How was Jesus own body, later prepared for his burial?

3· Also the **cloth** that had been upon his head, not lying with the bandages, but separately rolled up in one place. (**John 20:7**)

[Question] Where were Jesus' bandages, and what did this indicate that the angels had assisted him with, at his own resurrection?

4· Finally Yehowah listened to Elijah's voice, so that the soul of the child **came** back within him, and he **came** to life. (**1 Kings 17:22**)

[Question] What did the prayer of faith by Elijah bring about for the boy?

5· And it **came about** that as they were burying a man, why, here they saw the marauding band. At once they threw the man into Elisha's burial place and went off. When the man touched the bones of Elisha, he immediately **came** to life, and stood upon his **feet**. (**2 Kings 13:21**)

[Question] What happened to a man thrown into the burial place of Elisha?

6· Then Simon Peter also **came** following him, and he entered into the memorial tomb. And he viewed the bandages lying. (**John 20:6**)

[Question] Who followed John to the memorial tomb of Jesus, and what did he observe there?
