

John 11:48~ If we let him alone this way, they will all put faith in him, and the Romans will come and take away both our place,¹ and our nation.

1· So they reasoned, that if they let him alone then all those who once looked to them for religious guidance would all go to him, and then the Romans would come, and take away both their nation and the religious leaders' place within Israel.

[Question] What did the religious leaders reason out, would take place, if they let Jesus alone?

2· If I had not done among them, the works that no one else did, they would have no sin, but now they have both seen and hated me, as well as my Father. (John 15:24)

[Question] Why did the Jews have a heavy responsibility for their sins before Yehowah God?

[Question] What did their refusal to accept his work among them, show about how they felt about Yehowah God?

3· And after the sixty-two weeks Messiah will be cut off, with nothing for himself. And the city, and the holy place, the people of a leader that is coming, will bring to their ruin. And the end of it will be by the flood. And until the end there will be war. What is decided upon is desolations. (Daniel 9:26)

[Question] What had the prophecy of Daniel show, would happen to the Messiah during the seventieth week of years?

4· However, three days later he called together those who were the principal men of the Jews. When they had assembled, he proceeded to say to them; Men, brothers, although I had done nothing contrary to the people or the customs of our forefathers, I was delivered over as a prisoner from Jerusalem, into the hands of the Romans. (Acts of Apostles 28:17)

[Question] How did Paul later testify as to how the Jews mistreated him over his faith?

5· Therefore, when you catch sight of the disgusting thing

that causes desolation, as spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in a holy **place**, let the reader use discernment. (**Matthew 24:15**)

[Question] What disgusting thing are anointed Christians told to look out for, and what will be required to identify it?

- 6· And they brought forward false witnesses, who said; This man does not stop speaking things against this holy **place**, and against the Law. (**Acts of Apostles 6:13**)

[Question] How did the Jews complain about Stephen causing his death?

- 7· And as for the fourth kingdom, it **will** prove to be strong like iron. Forasmuch as iron is crushing and grinding everything else, so, like iron that shatters, it **will** crush and shatter even all these. (**Daniel 2:40**)

[Question] How did Daniel prophesy about the fourth Kingdom, and what it would do, and when did this Kingdom exist in world history?

- 8· However, when he was in Jerusalem at the Passover, at its festival, many people **put** their **faith** in his name, viewing his signs that he was performing. (**John 2:23**)

[Question] How did many people come to view the works of Jesus Christ, causing them to do what?

- 9· Therefore the Pharisees said among themselves; You observe you are getting absolutely nowhere. See! The world has gone after him. (**John 12:19**)

[Question] What did the Pharisees fear losing to Jesus, for how well known and loved was he among the common people?
