

John 11:49~ But a certain one of them, Caiaphas, who was High Priest that year, said to them; You do not know anything at all.

- 1· Yet a certain one of them, the High Priest, Caiaphas counseled them that they did not know anything.

[Question] Who then, came forth and counseled them?

- 2· Then the chief **priests** and the older men of the people gathered together in the courtyard of the **High Priest** who was called **Caiaphas**. (**Matthew 26:3**)

[Question] Where did the older men gather together to try Jesus in the middle of the night?

- 3· In the days of chief **priest** Annas and of **Caiaphas**, God's declaration came to John the son of Zechariah in the wilderness. (**Luke 3:2**)

[Question] Who was the High Priest within Israel, when John the Baptist started his ministry to Israel?

- 4· Also Annas the chief **priest** and **Caiaphas** and John and Alexander, and as many as were of the chief priest's kinsfolk. (**Acts of Apostles 4:6**)

[Question] Who also gathered together in the High Priest's home, to try Jesus in the middle of the night?

- 5· And took counsel together to seize Jesus by crafty device and kill him. (**Matthew 26:4**)

[Question] What did these older men then do, to seize Jesus, since they could find no fault with him?
