Therefore from that day on, they took counsel to kill him.

1· Therefore from that day onward, they took counsel to kill Jesus, for they feared him, and what he might lead their nation to.

[Question] What then, did the Jews take counsel to do, from that day onward, and why?

2· And took counsel together to seize Jesus by crafty device, and kill him. (Matthew 26:4)

[Question] Why did the Jews have to resort to crafty device to seize Jesus?

3· Meantime the chief priests and the entire Sanhedrin, were looking for false witness against Jesus, in order to put him to death. (Matthew 26:59)

[Question] What were the Jew looking for from others, so as to convict Jesus of serious sin, so as to have him put to death?

4· On this account, indeed, the Jews began seeking all the more to kill him, because not only was he breaking the Sabbath, but he was also calling God his own Father, making himself equal to God. (John 5:18)

[Question] Why did the Jews think, that Jesus was worthy of death?

5· At that the Pharisees went out and immediately began holding council with the party followers of Herod against him, in order to destroy him. (Mark 3:6)

[Question] What did the Pharisees do, and who did they take counsel with regarding Jesus?
