

**John 11:55~** Now the Passover of the Jews was near, and many people went up out of the country to Jerusalem, before the Passover, in order to cleanse themselves ceremonially.

1· Now the Passover of the Jews was getting near, and many people went up out of the country, heading to Jerusalem before the Passover, so as to cleanse themselves ceremonially.

**[Question]** What festival of the Jews was now near, and so what did many people then do, and why?

2· And this day must serve as a memorial for you, and you must celebrate it as a festival to Yehowah, throughout your generations. As a statute, to time indefinite, you should celebrate it. (**Exodus 12:14**)

**[Question]** What festival were the Jews commanded to celebrate throughout their generations to time indefinite?

3· Let there be an observing of the month of Abib, and you must celebrate the **Passover** to Yehowah your God, because in the month of Abib, Yehowah your God brought you **out** of Egypt by night. (**Deuteronomy 16:1**)

**[Question]** What month and day, were set aside for this observance?

4· Now the **Passover** of the **Jews** was **near**, and Jesus **went up to Jerusalem**. (**John 2:13**)

**[Question]** Where did Jesus often go, when this time of year came around?

5· After these things there was a festival of the **Jews**, and Jesus **went up to Jerusalem**. (**John 5:1**)

**[Question]** Where did Jesus always go at this time of year?

6· Now the **Passover**, the festival of the **Jews**, was **near**. (**John 6:4**)

**[Question]** Where did Jesus go to each year, in fulfillment of the Law?

7· Accordingly Jesus, six days **before the Passover**, arrived at Bethany, where Lazarus was, whom Jesus had raised up from the dead. (**John 12:1**)

**[Question]** Where did Jesus arrive some six days before the Passover celebration, and where did he stay then?

- 8· For there were **many** in the congregation, that had not sanctified themselves, and the Levites were in charge of slaughtering the **Passover** victims, for all that were not clean, to sanctify them to Yehowah. (**2 Chronicles 30:17**)

**[Question]** How did the Jews celebrate a Passover, in the days of Hezekiah?

- 9· And you must do the boiling and the eating, in the place that Yehowah your God will choose, and in the morning you must turn around, and go to your own tents. (**Deuteronomy 16:7**)
