John 11:8~ The disciples said to him; Rabbi, just lately the Judeans were seeking to stone you, and are you going there again?

Footnote: Or, Jews Greek, I-ou-dai'oi, as in (John 10:31,33)

1. Yet his disciples warned him, saying, that just lately, the Jews had tried to stone him, causing him to have to leave Jerusalem. They inferred, that it would be unwise to return there, in view of their hatred of him.

[Question] How though, did Jesus' disciples feel about going back to Jerusalem?

2. Then Jesus turned, and getting a view of them following, he said to them; What are you looking for? They said to him; Rabbi. Which means, when translated, Teacher; Where are you staying? (John 1:38)

[Question] How did Jesus' disciples often address him, and why?

3. Therefore they picked up stones to hurl them at him, but Jesus hid and went out of the temple. (John 8:59)

[Question] What did the Jews try to do to Jesus, on an earlier visit to Jerusalem?

4. Once more the Jews lifted up stones to stone him. (John 10:31)

[Question] What had the Jews again tried to do to Jesus, on his last visit to Jerusalem?

5. Therefore Thomas, who was called The Twin, said to his fellow disciples; Let us also go, that we may die with him. (John 11:16)

[Question] How did Thomas feel, when Jesus told him that Lazarus had died?
