

John 12:1~ Accordingly Jesus, six days before the Passover, arrived at Bethany, where Lazarus¹ was whom Jesus had raised up from the dead.

- 1· So just six days before the Passover, Jesus arrived in Bethany and went to the house of Lazarus, his friend, whom he had earlier raised up from the dead.**

[Question] Where did Jesus first go to, six days before the Passover that year?

[Question] What had Jesus earlier done for Lazarus?

- 2· Now when they were getting near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, he dispatched two of his disciples. (Mark 11:1)**

[Question] What did Jesus then do as they neared the Mount of Olives with Bethany in view?

- 3· Now there was a certain man sick, Lazarus of Bethany, of the village of Mary and of Martha her sister. (John 11:1)**

[Question] Who did Jesus know in Bethany?

- 4· And when he had said these things, he cried out with a loud voice; Lazarus, come on out! (John 11:43)**

[Question] What did Jesus say when he resurrected his friend Lazarus?

- 5· Now the Passover of the Jews was near, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. (John 2:13)**

[Question] What was then near, and so where did Jesus go?

- 6· Now the Passover of the Jews was near, and many people went up out of the country to Jerusalem, before the Passover, in order to cleanse themselves ceremonially. (John 11:55)**

[Question] What did many people do when the Passover celebration neared, and why?
