John 12:1~ Accordingly Jesus, six days before the Passover, arrived at Bethany, where Lazarus<sup>1</sup> was whom Jesus had raised up from the dead.

1. So just six days before the Passover, Jesus arrived in Bethany and went to the house of Lazarus, his friend, whom he had earlier raised up from the dead.

[Question] Where did Jesus first go to, six days before the Passover that year?

[Question] What had Jesus earlier done for Lazarus?

2. Now when they were getting near to Jerusalem, to Bethphage and Bethany at the Mount of Olives, he dispatched two of his disciples. (Mark 11:1)

[Question] What did Jesus then do as they neared the Mount of Olives with Bethany in view?

3. Now there was a certain man sick, Lazarus of Bethany, of the village of Mary and of Martha her sister. (John 11:1)

[Question] Who did Jesus know in Bethany?

4. And when he had said these things, he cried out with a loud voice; Lazarus, come on out! (John 11:43)

[Question] What did Jesus say when he resurrected his friend Lazarus?

5. Now the Passover of the Jews was near, and Jesus went up to Jerusalem. (John 2:13)

[Question] What was then near, and so where did Jesus go?

6. Now the Passover of the Jews was near, and many people went up out of the country to Jerusalem, before the Passover, in order to cleanse themselves ceremonially. (John 11:55)

[Question] What did many people do when the Passover celebration neared, and why?
