John 12:13~ Took the branches of palm trees, and went out to meet him. And they began to shout; Save, we pray you! Blessed is he that comes in Yehowah's name, even the king of Israel!

1. Then as Jesus entered the city of Jerusalem, they took palm branches, and went on out to meet him. Also they shouted; Save we pray. Blessed is he who comes in Yehowah's name, even the king of Israel.

[Question] Who then, went out to meet Jesus the next day as he entered into Jerusalem?

[Question] What then, did the crowds do, and say?

2. Most of the crowd spread their outer garments on the road, while others began cutting down branches from the trees, and spreading them on the road. (Matthew 21:8)

[Question] What did many within the crowds do, with their outer garments and with branches of trees?

3. Also, many spread their outer garments on the road, but others cut down foliage from the fields. (Mark 11:8)

[Question] Where then, would many spread their garments and lay the branches of trees, and what did this show?

4. After these things I saw, and, look! A great crowd, which no man was able to number, out of all nations and tribes and peoples and tongues, standing before the throne, and before the Lamb, dressed in white robes, and there were palm branches in their hands. (Revelation 7:9)

[Question] What future vision is shown in Revelation of the Lamb, and who is welcoming him as king, in a similar fashion?

5. As for the crowds, those going ahead of him and those following kept crying out; Save, we pray, the Son of David! Blessed is he that comes in Yehowah's name! Save him, we pray, in the heights above! (Matthew 21:9)

[Question] What would the crowd ahead and behind of Jesus cry out, as he approached Jerusalem?

6. And those going in front, and those coming behind, kept crying out; Save, we pray! Blessed is he that comes in Yehowah's name! (Mark 11:9)

[Question] What were the people then crying out, to welcome him as Israel's incoming king?

7. Ah, now, Yehowah, do save, please! Ah, now, Yehowah, do grant success, please! (Psalms 118:25)

[Question] What did the Psalmist say in a similar vein?

8' Blessed be the One coming in the name of Yehowah, we have blessed you people out of the house of Yehowah. (Psalms 118:26)

[Question] How does the Psalmist show, about how men should feel, about the one coming in Yehowah's name?

9. Nathanael answered him; Rabbi, you are the Son of God, you are King of Israel. (John 1:49)

[Question] What did Nathaniel say to Jesus after a few moments of conversation with him?

10. And God said further to him; I, am God Almighty. Be fruitful and become many. Nations, and a congregation of nations, will proceed out of you, and kings will come out of your loins. (Genesis 35:11)

[Question] What promise did Yehowah God make to Jacob and to his offspring?

11. And you must take for yourselves on the first day, the fruit of splendid trees, the fronds of palm trees, and the boughs of branchy trees, and poplars of the torrent valley, and you must rejoice before Yehowah your God seven days.

(Leviticus 23:40)

[Question] What festival of Yehowah used the branches of trees, and what did it depict?

12. Yehowah is the Divine One, and he gives us light. Bind the festival procession with boughs, O you people, as far as the horns of the altar. (Psalms 118:27)

[Question] How did the Psalmist show how the procession to the altar should be conducted?

13. Others he saved. Himself he cannot save! He is King of Israel? Let him now come down off the torture stake, and we will believe on him. (Matthew 27:42)

[Question] How did some of Jesus' opposers scornfully mock him, after he was thus welcomed as king of Israel?

14. Look! Your house is abandoned to you. I tell you, you will by no means see me until you say; Blessed is he that comes in Yehowah's name. (Luke 13:35)

[Question] What did Jesus reveal to his opposers, that was no longer within their house of worship the temple?

[Question] When only, would they experience Yehowah God's favor again?

15. So Pilate entered into the governor's palace again, and called Jesus, and said to him; Are you the king of the Jews? (John 18:33)

[Question] What question did Pilate ask of Jesus, no doubt because this procession had taken place days earlier, and he had heard of it?
