

John 12:15~ Have no fear, daughter of Zion. Look! Your king is coming, seated upon an ass' colt.

- 1· This scripture taken from Zechariah and also in Zephaniah told the daughter of Zion not to be fearful, for her king is coming seated upon an ass' colt.

[Question] Where is the scripture, that John here quotes taken from, and what did it foretell about Israel's coming king?

- 2· And Zadok the priest and Nathan the prophet must anoint him there as **king** over Israel, and you must blow the horn and say, Let King Solomon live! (**1 Kings 1:34**)

[Question] What did David tell his closest advisers to do, to show the people that Solomon was the king of Israel?

- 3· Be very joyful, O **daughter** of **Zion**. Shout in triumph, O **daughter** of Jerusalem. **Look!** Your **king** himself comes to you. He is righteous, yes, saved, humble, and riding upon an ass, even upon a full-grown animal, the son of a she-ass. (**Zechariah 9:9**)

[Question] What did the prophecy of Zechariah state, about Israel's coming king?

- 4· **Look!** Yehowah himself has caused it to be heard to the farthest part of the earth; Say, you people, to the **daughter** of **Zion**; Look! Your salvation is **coming**. **Look!** The reward he gives is with him, and the wages he pays are before him. (**Isaiah 62:11**)

[Question] What did Isaiah also state about this coming one?

- 5· And as for you, O tower of the drove, the mound of the **daughter** of **Zion**, as far as to you it will come, yes, the first dominion will certainly come, the kingdom belonging to the **daughter** of Jerusalem. (**Micah 4:8**)

[Question] What did Micah state about the first dominion belonging to the daughter of Zion?

- 6· In that day it will be said to Jerusalem; Do not be afraid, O **Zion**. May your hands not drop down. (**Zephaniah 3:16**)

[Question] How did Zephaniah prophesy that Israel should not feel then?

- 7· Tell the **daughter of Zion; Look!** Your King is **coming** to you, mild-tempered, and mounted upon an ass, yes, upon a colt, the offspring of a beast of burden. (**Matthew 21:5**)

[Question] How did Matthew show that these prophecies were fulfilled?
