John 12:16~ These things his disciples took no note of at first, but when Jesus became glorified, then they called to mind that these things were written respecting him, and that they did these things to him.

1. So at the time that these things were actually happening to Jesus, the disciples took no note, but later they called to mind, that the scriptures had foretold such things happening to the Messiah, and here, they had happened to Jesus.

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples not take note of directly when it happened?

[Question] What though, did they later come to realize?

2. However, they did not get the meaning of any of these things, but this utterance was hidden from them, and they were not knowing the things said. (Luke 18:34)

[Question] What did Jesus' disciples not get the meaning of in real time, and why?

3. However, he said this concerning the spirit which those who put faith in him were about to receive, for as yet, there was no spirit, because Jesus had not yet been glorified. (John 7:39)

[Question] Were Jesus' disciples then guided by the Holy Spirit to understand, for when did this first come?

4. Then he opened up their minds fully to grasp the meaning of the Scriptures. (Luke 24:45)

[Question] What did Jesus open the minds of his disciples to see clearly, and when did this happen?

5. But the helper, the Holy Spirit, which the Father will send in my name, that one will teach you all things, and bring back to your minds, all the things I told you. (John 14:26)

[Question] What did Jesus tell them that would come to them, and what would it do for them?

[Question] Why can we be sure, that the events they recorded about Jesus' life, are accurate and true?

6. When, though, he was raised up from the dead, his disciples called to mind, that he used to say this, and they

believed the Scripture, and the saying that Jesus said. (John 2:22)
