

John 12:17~ Accordingly the crowd that was with him when he called Lazarus out of the memorial tomb, and raised him up from the dead, kept bearing witness.

- 1· So the people who had been with Jesus when he raised Lazarus from the dead, were all bearing witness to this, before the gathered crowds.

[Question] What did the people in the crowd that saw Lazarus raised from the dead by Jesus, keep calling out?

- 2· Now there was a certain man sick, **Lazarus** of Bethany, of the village of Mary and of Martha her sister. (**John 11:1**)

[Question] Who were the relatives of Lazarus, Jesus' friend?

- 3· And when he had said these things, he cried **out** with a loud voice: Lazarus, come on out! (**John 11:43**)

[Question] What did Jesus say to effect the resurrection of Lazarus?

- 4· When the chief priests and the scribes saw the marvelous things he did, and the boys that were crying **out** in the temple and saying; Save, we pray, the Son of David! They became indignant (**Matthew 21:15**)

[Question] What were young boys crying out in the temple as Jesus approached?

- 5· As soon as he got near the road down the Mount of Olives all the multitude of the disciples started to rejoice and praise God with a loud voice concerning all the powerful works they had seen. (**Luke 19:37**)

[Question] What did the people then do, as Jesus neared Jerusalem, coming down the road from the Mount of Olives?
