

**John 12:21~** These, therefore, approached Philip who was from Bethsaida of Galilee, and they began to request him, saying: Sir, we want to see Jesus.

**1·** Therefore they approached Phillip, who was from Bethsaida of Galilee, and they began to request him saying, that they wanted to get an audience with Jesus, to speak to him.

**[Question]** Who then, approached Phillip, and what did they ask of him?

**2·** Now **Philip** was from **Bethsaida**, from the city of Andrew and Peter. (**John 1:44**)

**[Question]** Where was Phillip from, and also Andrew and Peter originally?

**3·** Well, he was seeking to **see** who this Jesus was, but he could not, for the crowd, because he was small in size. (**Luke 19:3**)

**[Question]** How did Zacchaeus, despite his small size, get the attention of Jesus, amid a large crowd near Jericho?

**4·** When Herod saw Jesus he rejoiced greatly, for over a considerable time he was wanting to **see** him, because of having heard about him, and he was hoping to **see** some sign performed by him. (**Luke 23:8**)

**[Question]** How did Herod feel when Pilate sent Jesus to him for questioning?

**5·** Woe to you, Chorazin! Woe to you, **Bethsaida**! Because if the powerful works had taken place in Tyre and Sidon, that took place in you, they would long ago have repented in sackcloth and ashes. (**Matthew 11:21**)

**[Question]** What regions did Jesus say would not fare well, and why?
