John 12:23~ But Jesus answered them, saying; The hour has come for the Son of man to be glorified.

1. Yet Jesus answered them, that the hour for him to be glorified had come.

[Question] What hour did Jesus then tell them, that had not yet come?

2. And God will himself glorify him, and he will glorify him immediately. (John 13:32)

[Question] How did Yehowah God glorify Jesus, days later, though he was put to a shameful death by men?

3. Jesus spoke these things, and, raising his eyes to heaven, he said; Father, the hour has come, glorify your son, that your son may glorify you. (John 17:1)

[Question] What did Jesus look up to heaven, and say before the crowds?

4. But Jesus said to her; What have I to do with you, woman? My hour has not yet come. (John 2:4)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his mother at the wedding feast in Cana of Galilee?

5. Now, because he knew before the festival of the Passover, that his hour had come for him to move out of this world to the Father, Jesus, having loved his own that were in the world, loved them to the end. (John 13:1)

[Question] When did Jesus know, that he must be sacrificed, and how did he feel about his disciples to the very end?

6. Hence when he had gone out, Jesus said; Now the Son of man is glorified, and God is glorified in connection with him. (John 13:31)

[Question] What did Jesus state to his disciples at the Memorial celebration?
