

John 12:23~ But Jesus answered them, saying; **The hour has come for the Son of man to be glorified.**

- 1· Yet Jesus answered them, that the hour for him to be glorified had come.

[Question] What hour did Jesus then tell them, that had not yet come?

- 2· And God will himself glorify him, and he will glorify him immediately. (**John 13:32**)

[Question] How did Yehowah God glorify Jesus, days later, though he was put to a shameful death by men?

- 3· Jesus spoke these things, and, raising his eyes to heaven, he said; Father, the **hour has come**, glorify your son, that your son may glorify you. (**John 17:1**)

[Question] What did Jesus look up to heaven, and say before the crowds?

- 4· But Jesus said to her; What have I to do with you, woman? My **hour has** not yet come. (**John 2:4**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his mother at the wedding feast in Cana of Galilee?

- 5· Now, because he knew before the festival of the Passover, that his **hour** had **come** for him to move out of this world to the Father, Jesus, having loved his own that were in the world, loved them to the end. (**John 13:1**)

[Question] When did Jesus know, that he must be sacrificed, and how did he feel about his disciples to the very end?

- 6· Hence when he had gone out, Jesus said; Now the **Son of man is glorified**, and God is **glorified** in connection with him. (**John 13:31**)

[Question] What did Jesus state to his disciples at the Memorial celebration?
