

John 12:26~ If anyone would minister¹ to me, let him follow me, and where I am, there my minister will be also. If anyone would minister to me, the Father will honor him.

1· So Jesus told them, that if anyone wanted to be his follower, then that one should minister to Jesus, and then where Jesus was, there his minister would be also. Then Jesus told them that anyone who would thus minister to Jesus, God would honor all such ones.

[Question] Where must anyone wanting to be Christ's minister follow?

[Question] What does this say,, about what course anointed Christians must follow today?

2· Also, if I go my way and prepare a place for you, I **am** coming again and **will** receive you home to myself, that where I **am** you also may be. (**John 14:3**)

[Question] Where did Jesus tell his disciples, that he himself was going, and for what purpose?

3· **Father**, as to what you have given me, I wish, that where I **am**, they also may be with me, in order to behold my glory, that you have given me, because you loved me before the founding of the world. (**John 17:24**)

[Question] What did Jesus want his disciples to see, about how he lived before in heaven, with his heavenly Father, Yehowah God?

4· Afterward, we the living who are surviving **will**, together with them, be caught away in clouds to meet the Lord in the air, and thus we shall always be with the Lord. (**1 Thessalonians 4:17**)

[Question] What did Paul show would happen to those anointed Christians living during the presence of Christ?

5· That is why the utterance of Yehowah the God of Israel is; I did indeed say; As for your house and the house of your forefather, they **will** walk before me to time indefinite. But now the utterance of Yehowah is; It is unthinkable, on my part, because those honoring me, I shall **honor**, and those

despising me, **will** be of little account. (**1 Samuel 2:30**)

[Question] Who did Yehowah God show that he would honor?

- 6· **My eyes are upon the faithful ones of the earth, that they may dwell with me. The one walking in a faultless way, he it is who **will minister** to me. (**Psalms 101:6**)**

[Question] Who does Yehowah God want to come to heaven to dwell with him, since he is a lover of righteousness?

- 7· **This he said to signify by what sort of death he would glorify God. So, when he had said this, he said to him; Continue following me. (**John 21:19**)**
