

John 12:28~ **Father, glorify your name. Therefore a voice came out of heaven; I both glorified it, and will glorify it again.**

1· So Jesus spoke out loud to Yehowah, his heavenly Father, asking him to glorify his name. Then a voice responded out of heaven; **I both glorified it and will glorify it again.** And all those present heard it.

[Question] How did Yehowah God now respond to Jesus' asking him to glorify his own name, and who heard this voice?

2· Look! Also, there was a **voice** from the **heavens** that said; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I have approved. **(Matthew 3:17)**

[Question] What voice came from the heavens when Jesus was baptized, and how did it identify Jesus Christ?

3· While he was yet speaking, look! A bright cloud overshadowed them, and, look! A **voice out** of the cloud, saying; This is my Son, the beloved, whom I have approved. Listen to him. **(Matthew 17:5)**

[Question] What voice was heard from heaven at the mountain of transfiguration, and what did it identify Jesus as being?

4· And a **voice came out** of the **heavens**; You are my Son, the beloved. I have approved you. **(Mark 1:11)**

[Question] How did Yehowah God give witness concerning Jesus, when Jesus was baptized?

5· And a cloud formed, overshadowing them, and a **voice came out** of the cloud; This is my Son, the beloved. Listen to him. **(Mark 9:7)**

[Question] Whose voice was heard by three of Jesus' disciples on the mountain of transfiguration, and what did it say?

6· And the Holy Spirit in bodily shape like a dove **came down** upon him, and a **voice came out** of **heaven**; You are my Son, the beloved. I have approved you. **(Luke 3:22)**

[Question] What happened when Jesus was baptized, and what did a voice from heaven then declare about Jesus?

- 7· And a **voice came out** of the cloud, saying; This is my Son, the one that has been chosen. Listen to him. (**Luke 9:35**)

[Question] Whose voice was heard in the mountain of transfiguration by three of Jesus' disciples, and what did it say?

- 8· For he received from God the Father honor and glory, when words such as these were borne to him by the magnificent glory; This is my son, my beloved, whom I myself have approved. (**2 Peter 1:17**)

[Question] What did Jesus receive from his heavenly Father, Yehowah God in the mountain of transfiguration?

- 9· Jesus spoke these things, and, raising his eyes to **heaven**, he said; Father, the hour has come, **therefore glorify** your son, that your son may **glorify** you. (**John 17:1**)

[Question] What did Jesus later say when alone with his disciples?

- 10· At this God said to Moses; **I SHALL PROVE TO BE, WHAT I SHALL PROVE TO BE**. And he added; This is what you are to say to the sons of Israel, **I SHALL PROVE TO BE** has sent me to you. (**Exodus 3:14**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God state to Moses to help him understand, what he would become in behalf of his people Israel?

- 11· And I used to appear to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob as God Almighty, but as respects my name Yehowah, I did not make myself known to them. (**Exodus 6:3**)

[Question] How had Yehowah God been known to Abraham, Isaac and Jacob?

[Question] How though, did they come to understand his name better, as he came to fulfill his promises earlier made to these men?

- 12· And let your own name become great to time indefinite, saying, Yehowah of armies is God over Israel, and let the very house of your servant David become firmly established before you. (**2 Samuel 7:26**)

[Question] What did David say about the name and fame of Yehowah God?

- 13· And let your name prove faithful and become great to time

indefinite, saying, Yehowah of armies, the God of Israel, is God to Israel, and let the house of David your servant be one lasting before you. (**1 Chronicles 17:24**)

[Question] What did David call for the name of Yehowah God to become to time indefinite?

[Question] How is that name glorified, when Yehowah God keeps his promises to men like King David, and many others?

14· To us belongs nothing, O Yehowah, to us belongs nothing, but to your name give glory, according to your loving-kindness, according to your trueness. (**Psalms 115:1**)

[Question] What did the Psalmist attribute to Yehowah God, and why?

15· So too, the Christ did not **glorify** himself, by becoming a High Priest, but was **glorified** by him, who spoke with reference to him; You are my son. I, today, I have become your father. (**Hebrews 5:5**)

[Question] Who glorified Jesus Christ, and how did he do this?

16· If we receive the witness men give, the witness God gives is greater, because this is the witness God gives, the fact that he has borne witness concerning his Son. (**1 John 5:9**)

[Question] What witness does Yehowah God give, as recorded in several places within the gospel accounts, of Jesus' life?

17· Who **will** not really fear you, Yehowah, and **glorify** your name, because you alone are loyal? For all the nations **will** come and worship before you, because your righteous decrees have been made manifest. (**Revelation 15:4**)

[Question] Why does the Revelation account say, that men would come to fear Yehowah God, and what would they then do before him?
