John 12:30~ In answer Jesus said; This voice has occurred, not for my sake, but for your sakes.

1. So Jesus told the crowds, that this voice had occurred, not for his sake, but primarily for their sake.

[Question] Why then, did Jesus tell them, that this voice had been made manifest to them?

2. True, I knew that you always hear me, but on account of the crowd standing around I spoke, in order, that they might believe that you sent me forth. (John 11:42)

[Question] What did Jesus say to Yehowah God when resurrecting Lazarus?

3. There is another that bears witness about me, and I know that the witness which he bears about me is true. (John 5:32)

[Question] Who did Jesus say bore witness about him, and could that witness be believed?

4. Also, the Father who sent me has himself borne witness about me. You have neither heard his voice at any time nor seen his figure. (John 5:37)

[Question] What did Jesus tell unbelieving Jews, that his father had done regarding him, but that they had never heard?
