Jesus therefore said to them; The light will be among you a little while longer. Walk while you have the light, so that darkness does not overpower you, and he that walks in the darkness does not know where he is going.

1. So rather than say, that it was he himself, he answered, that the light would be among them for only a little while longer. Thus while they had the light they needed to walk, so that the darkness would not overpower them. This, because he who walks in the darkness, does not know where he is going.

[Question] What did Jesus say, rather than to clearly identify himself as the Son Of Man?

[Question] What then, did he tell them that they needed to do, while he was still among them, and how did he illustrate this?

2. He had earlier told them that he was the light of the world, and so he was the light they needed to follow, so as not to stumble in the coming spiritual darkness.

[Question] What had he earlier told them that he was, and so who did they need to follow to avoid stumbling?

3. Give to Yehowah your God glory, before he causes darkness, and before your feet strike up against each other on the mountains at dusk. And you will certainly hope for the light, and he will actually make it deep shadow, he will turn it into thick gloom. (Jeremiah 13:16)

[Question] What did Jeremiah tell his countrymen, that Yehowah God gave them, and how should they use this light, while they had it?

4. But if anyone walks in the night, he bumps against something, because the light is not in him. (John 11:10)

[Question] What did Jesus say about anyone walking in the nighttime?

5. From those leaving the paths of uprightness, to walk in the ways of darkness. (Proverbs 2:13)

[Question] What are people like to turn to badness?

6. The way of the wicked ones is like the gloom. They have not known at what they keep stumbling. (Proverbs 4:19)

[Question] What is the way of wicked ones like, and do they even see what causes them to stumble in life?

7. And the light is shining in the darkness, but the darkness has not overpowered it. (John 1:5)

[Question] What was Jesus within the world of his day, and could the powers of that darkness, overpower the light of the Christ?

[Question] What proves that, even down to this day?

8. Therefore Jesus spoke again to them, saying; I am the light of the world. He that follows me will by no means walk in darkness, but will possess the light of life. (John 8:12)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, that he himself was, while within this world of darkness, ruled by Satan the Devil?

[Question] What also, would anyone following after Jesus Christ, possess within this world?

9. I have come as a light into the world, in order, that everyone putting faith in me, may not remain in the darkness. (John 12:46)

[Question] What had Jesus come forth into the world as, for what would anyone putting faith in him, not walk in any longer?

10" But he that hates his brother is in the darkness, and is walking in the darkness, and he does not know where he is going, because the darkness has blinded his eyes. (1 John 2:11)

[Question] What is anyone who hates his brother in his heart, walking in, for what had blinded his eyes?
