

John 12:36~ While you have the light, exercise faith in the light, in order to become sons of light. Jesus spoke these things, and went off and hid from them.

- 1· So Jesus told them, that while they had this bright light, that they must walk by means of it, in order to become sons of light. Then after Jesus had spoken these things to them, he went off and hid from the crowds.

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples to put faith in while it was among them, and so what would they then become?

[Question] Where did Jesus go to, after saying these things?

- 2· For you were once darkness, but you are now light, in connection with the Lord. Go on walking as children of light. (Ephesians 5:8)

[Question] What were anointed Christians before coming to know Christ, but what are they now in respect to others, and so how should they walk?

- 3· You are the light of the world. A city cannot be hid when situated upon a mountain (Matthew 5:14)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples that they were, within the world?

[Question] What did he infer, by saying that a light put upon a mountain could not be hid?

- 4· And his master commended the steward, though unrighteous, because he acted with practical wisdom, for the sons of this system of things are wiser in a practical way toward their own generation, than the sons of the light are. (Luke 16:8)

[Question] What did Jesus say about the sons of men in reference to the angels in one of his parables?

- 5· But he that does what is true comes to the light, in order, that his works may be made manifest, as having been worked in harmony with God. (John 3:21)

[Question] Who does the one that does what is true, want to come to, and why?

6· For you are all **sons of light** and **sons of day**. We, belong neither to night, nor to darkness. (**1 Thessalonians 5:5**)

[Question] What are all true anointed Christians, and what do they belong to?
