

John 12:4~ But Judas Iscariot, one of his disciples, who was about to betray him, said;

- 1· However Judas Iscariot, who was about to betray him spoke out in complaint against this waste.

[Question] Who though, complained against this waste?

- 2· And while he was yet speaking, look! Judas, one of the twelve, came and with him a great crowd with swords and clubs from the chief priests and older men of the people. (Matthew 26:47)

[Question] Who later came out with the chief priests and arrested Jesus, thus betraying him?

- 3· And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went off to the chief priests in order to betray him to them. (Mark 14:10)

[Question] What did Judas go off and do, after this happened?

- 4· But Jesus said to him; Judas, do you betray the Son of man with a kiss? (Luke 22:48)

[Question] What did Jesus say to Judas, showing that his betrayal was known?

- 5· Some, in fact, were imagining, since Judas was holding the money box, that Jesus was telling him; Buy what things we need for the festival, or that he should give something to the poor. (John 13:29)

[Question] What did some of Jesus' disciples think, when Jesus dismissed Judas from the Memorial supper?

- 6· Men, brothers, it was necessary for the scripture to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by David's mouth, about Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus. (Acts of Apostles 1:16)

[Question] What did Peter later testify about Judas, and why he betrayed Jesus?

- 7· On seeing this, the disciples became indignant, and said; Why this waste? (Matthew 26:8)

[Question] What did the disciples think, when this costly oil was poured out upon Jesus' head?

- 8· At this there were some expressing indignation among themselves; Why has this waste of the perfumed oil taken place? (Mark 14:4)**

[Question] How did some of Jesus' disciples feel, when this happened?
