But Judas Iscariot, one of his disciples, who was about to betray him, said;

1. However Judas Iscariot, who was about to betray him spoke out in complaint against this waste.

[Question] Who though, complained against this waste?

2. And while he was yet speaking, look! Judas, one of the twelve, came and with him a great crowd with swords and clubs from the chief priests and older men of the people.

(Matthew 26:47)

3. And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went off to the chief priests in order to betray him to them. (Mark 14:10)

6 Men, brothers, it was necessary for the scripture to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by David's mouth, about Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus. (Acts of Apostles 1:16)

[Question] What did Peter later testify about Judas, and why he betrayed Jesus?

7. On seeing this, the disciples became indignant, and said; Why this waste? (Matthew 26:8)
