

**John 12:47~** But if anyone hears my sayings and does not keep them, I do not judge him, for I came, not to judge the world, but to save the world.

**1· Jesus then said, that if anyone hears his sayings, and yet does not do them, that he will not judge such a one, for he came into the world not to judge the world, but to save the world.**

**[Question]** Did Jesus state, that he would judge anyone hearing his words and not doing them, for why had he come into the world?

**2· For God sent forth his Son into the world, not for him to judge the world, but for the world to be saved through him. (John 3:17)**

**[Question]** What did Yehowah God send forth his son into the world to do toward the world of mankind?

**3· Do not think that I will accuse you to the Father, there is one that accuses you, Moses, in whom you have put your hope. (John 5:45)**

**[Question]** Who accused those who put their faith in Moses, but who rejected Jesus?

**4· You judge according to the flesh. I do not judge any man at all. (John 8:15)**

**[Question]** What did the men Jesus spoke to judge by, and how did Jesus judge?

**5· For God loved the world so much, that he gave his only-begotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him, might not be destroyed, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)**

**[Question]** How did Yehowah God show his great love for mankind, and what do those exercising faith in his son obtain through Christ?

**6· And Jesus said; For this judgment I came into this world. That those not seeing, might see, and those seeing, might become blind. (John 9:39)**

**[Question]** For what judgment did Jesus Christ come into the world?

**7· In addition, we ourselves have beheld and are bearing**

witness, that the Father has sent forth his Son, as Savior of the world. (1 John 4:14)

**[Question]** Why did Yehowah God send Jesus into the world, and what does Jesus serve as to mankind?
