5. For God loved the world so much, that he gave his onlybegotten Son, in order, that everyone exercising faith in him, might not be destroyed, but have everlasting life. (John 3:16)

[Question] How did Yehowah God show his great love for mankind, and what do those exercising faith in his son obtain through Christ?

6. And Jesus said; For this judgment I came into this world. That those not seeing, might see, and those seeing, might become blind. (John 9:39)

[Question] For what judgment did Jesus Christ come into the world?

7. In addition, we ourselves have beheld and are bearing
