

John 12:48~ He that disregards me, and does not receive my sayings, has one to judge him. The word that I have spoken, is what will judge him in the last day.

1· Then he said about people who might hear him, and yet not do what he said, such ones had one alone who would judge them, for the very words that he had spoken, would judge them at the Last Day.

[Question] What word did Jesus state would be the judge of people who heard his words, but did not practice and obey them?

2· And it must occur, that the man who **will** not listen to my **words**, that he, **Christ**, **will** speak in my name, I shall myself require an account from him. (**Deuteronomy 18:19**)

[Question] What did Yehowah God state, he would hold accountable for not listening to his words through his prophets?

3· He that listens to you listens to me too. And he that disregards you disregards me too. Moreover, he that disregards me disregards also him that sent me forth. (**Luke 10:16**)

[Question] What did Jesus show about anyone listening to his words, and about anyone disregarding them also?

4· Now this is the basis for judgment, that the light **has** come into the world, but men **have** loved the darkness, rather than the light, for their works were wicked. (**John 3:19**)

[Question] What is the basis of judgment for men?

[Question] How have men judged themselves by their actions?

5· And when that one arrives, he **will** give the world convincing evidence, concerning sin, and concerning righteousness, and concerning judgment. (**John 16:8**)

[Question] What did Jesus show would give convincing evidence concerning sin and concerning righteousness?

6· For the **word** of God is alive, and exerts power and is sharper than any two-edged sword, and pierces even to the dividing of soul and spirit, and of joints and their marrow, and is able to discern thoughts, and intentions of the heart.

(Hebrews 4:12)
