John 12:49~ Because I have not spoken out of my own impulse, but the Father himself who sent me, has given me a commandment, as to what to tell, and what to speak.

1. Jesus then told them, that he had spoken nothing out of his own initiative or volition. When he spoke, it was the Father himself who had given him the commandment, as to what to speak and tell the people.

[Question] Where did Jesus state, that all the things he spoke came forth from?

2. A prophet I shall raise up for them from the midst of their brothers, like you, and I shall indeed put my words in his mouth, and he will certainly speak to them, all that I shall command him. (Deuteronomy 18:18)

[Question] What prophet did Yehowah God through Moses show, that he would raise up for Israel?

What things I have seen with my Father, I speak, and you, therefore, do the things you have heard from your father.
(John 8:38)

[Question] What things did Jesus Christ speak to men on earth, and where did he get these sayings?

4. Do you not believe that I am in union with the Father, and the Father is in union with me? The things I say to you men, I do not speak of my own originality, but the Father who remains in union with me, is doing his works. (John 14:10)

[Question] Who was Jesus always in union with, and who was doing his works through Jesus?

5. Therefore, in answer, Jesus went on to say to them; Most truly I say to you, the Son cannot do a single thing of his own initiative, but only what he beholds the Father doing. For whatever things that One does, these things the Son also does, in like manner. (John 5:19)

[Question]Did Jesus ever do anything, of his own initiative?[Question]Whose example, did he imitate perfectly in all that he did?

6. Jesus, in turn, answered them and said; What I teach is not mine, but belongs to him that sent me. (John 7:16)

[Question] Where did all the things Jesus taught come from?

7. He that does not love me, does not observe my words, and the word that you are hearing is not mine, but belongs to the Father who sent me. (John 14:24)

[Question] What does it mean to not obey Jesus, can one love Jesus if he does not obey Jesus?

[Question] Where did this very word or commandment come from?

8[•] But, in order for the world to know that I love the Father, even as the Father has given me commandment to do, so I am doing. Get up, let us go from here. (John 14:31)

[Question] What showed the world of mankind, that Jesus himself loved his heavenly Father?

9. Because the sayings that you gave me, I have given to them, and they have received them, and have certainly come to know, that I came out as your representative, and they have believed, that you sent me forth. (John 17:8)

[Question] Where did Jesus get his wisdom and teachings from, and what did his disciples come to know for certain?
