Footnote: Or, is

1· Also Jesus showed that the commandment of the Father, meant everlasting life for them, and therefore Jesus spoke just as the Father had told him to speak.

[Question] What did Jesus know that the commandment of the Father meant for his disciples?

2· For this is the will of my Father, that everyone that beholds the Son, and exercises faith in him, should have everlasting life, and I will resurrect him at the last day. (John 6:40)

[Question] What is the will of Yehowah God for all those putting faith in him through his son, Jesus Christ?

3· According as you have given him authority over all flesh, that, as regards the whole number whom you have given him, he may give them everlasting life. (John 17:2)

[Question] What authority does Jesus Christ have, and what does this authority give him the ability to give to others?

4· For the one whom God sent forth, speaks the sayings of God, for he does not give the spirit by measure. (John 3:34)

[Question] What did the one Yehowah God sent forth speak, and what controlled that?

5· And he would instruct me and say to me; May your heart keep fast hold of my words. Keep my commandments and continue living. (Proverbs 4:4)

[Question] What do the Proverbs encourage about keeping God's commandments?

6· Keep my commandments and continue living, and my Law like the pupil of your eyes. (Proverbs 7:2)

[Question] What will come to the one keeping Yehowah God's commandments?

7· In the beginning the Word was, and the Word was with

God, and the Word was a god. (John 1:1)

[Question] Where was the Word in the beginning of creation, and who was he with then, for a very long time?
