

**John 12:7~** Therefore Jesus said; **Let her alone, that she may keep this observance in view of the day of my burial.**

- 1· Yet Jesus rebuked them, and told them to leave her alone, for she had done a fine deed, in view of his coming burial.

**[Question]** What did Jesus then show, that her act of faith, was in preparation for?

- 2· For when this woman put this perfumed oil upon my body, she did it for the preparation of me for **burial**. (**Matthew 26:12**)

**[Question]** Why did she put the perfumed oil upon Jesus' body?

- 3· She did what she could, she undertook beforehand to put perfumed oil on my body, in **view** of the **burial**. (**Mark 14:8**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus show was the reason for her pouring the oil upon him?

- 4· So they took the body of Jesus, and bound it up with bandages with the spices, just the way the Jews have the custom of preparing for **burial**. (**John 19:40**)

**[Question]** What did others later do to Jesus dead body, to prepare it for burial?

- 5· So they buried him in his grand **burial** place, that he had excavated for himself in the City of David, and they laid him in the bed, that had been filled with balsam oil and different sorts of ointment, mixed in an ointment of special make. Further, they made an extraordinarily great funeral burning for him. (**2 Chronicles 16:14**)

**[Question]** What was common practice, for the burial of kings in Jerusalem?

- 6· But Jesus **said**; **Let her alone**. Why do you try to make trouble for her? She did a fine deed toward me. (**Mark 14:6**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his disciples, that this deed was, and how did he make them stop their objections?
