John 13:12~ When, now, he had washed their feet and had put his outer garments on and laid himself down at the table again, he said to them; Do you know what I have done to you?

1. So first Jesus, after having finished with all of them, returned his own outer garments onto himself, and sat down at the table again. Then he asked them a question to drive home his point about washing their feet. Did they understand what he had just done for them?

[Question] What then, did Jesus himself do, and after sitting down, what question did he ask of them?

2. And he proceeded to say; Please, now, my lords, turn aside, please, into the house of your servant and stay overnight and have your feet washed. Then you must get up early and travel on your way. To this they said; No, but in the public square is where we shall stay overnight. (Genesis 19:2)

[Question] How did Lot treat the angelic guests that came to Sodom and Gomorrah to investigate about the people there, for where did they want to stay?

3. In answer Jesus said to him; What I am doing you do not understand at present, but you will understand after these things. (John 13:7)

[Question] What did Jesus tell Peter that he could not understand at present?
