John 13:19~ From this moment on I am telling you before it occurs, in order, that when it does occur, you may believe, that I am he.

1. So Jesus said, that he was telling them about all the things that were about to occur, so that when they did occur, that they would know that this was the course, that events must follow. This also would convince them, that he was who he said he was.

[Question] Why did Jesus tell his disciples about upcoming events that would affect them, before they happened?

2. Look! I have forewarned you. (Matthew 24:25)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples beforehand, and why?

3. So now I have told you before it occurs, in order, that, when it does occur, you may believe. (John 14:29)

[Question] Why did Jesus tell his disciples things before they happened?

4 Nevertheless, I have spoken these things to you that, when the hour for them arrives, you may remember I told them to you. These things, however, I did not tell you at first, because I was with you. (John 16:4)

[Question] What did Jesus reveal was the reason, why he told his disciples things beforehand?

5. You, then, watch out! I have told you all things beforehand. (Mark 13:23)

[Question] What reason did Jesus give for telling his disciples things beforehand?
