

John 13:2~ So, while the evening meal was going on,¹ the Devil, having already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot, the son of Simon, to betray him.

1· So then while Jesus was celebrating the Passover, and because the Devil had already put it into the heart of Judas Iscariot to betray Jesus.

[Question] What prior festival of the Jews, were Jesus and his disciples celebrating?

[Question] What then entered into the heart of Judas Iscariot?

2· For example, out of the **heart** come wicked reasonings, murders, adulteries, fornications, thieveries, false testimonies, blasphemies. (**Matthew 15:19**)

[Question] What kinds of behaviors do wicked men practice?

3· But Satan entered into **Judas**, the one called **Iscariot**, who was numbered among the twelve. (**Luke 22:3**)

[Question] Whom did Satan the Devil enter into, on the night of the Passover?

4· And after the morsel, then Satan entered into the latter. Jesus, therefore, said to him; What you are doing get done more quickly. (**John 13:27**)

[Question] What did Jesus tell Judas Iscariot to get him out of the celebration, so that the others would not know what he was up to?

5· To take the place of this ministry and apostleship, from which **Judas** deviated to go to his own place. (**Acts of Apostles 1:25**)

[Question] What did Peter later recommend, that the disciples do, to replace unfaithful Judas Iscariot?

6· So from then on he kept seeking a good opportunity to **betray** him. (**Matthew 26:16**)

[Question] What was Judas Iscariot seeking to do, after he spoke with the chief priests and scribes?

- 7· True, the Son of man is **going** away, just as it is written concerning him, but woe to that man, through whom the Son of man is betrayed! It would have been finer for him, if that man had not been born. (**Matthew 26:24**)

[Question] What did Jesus state about the one who would betray him, even though it had to take place scripturally?

- 8· When they heard it, they rejoiced and promised to give him silver money. So he began seeking how to **betray** him conveniently. (**Mark 14:11**)

[Question] How did the chief priests and scribes feel, when Judas Iscariot came to them seeking to betray Jesus Christ?

- 9· Now it came to be the day when the **sons** of the true God entered to take their station before Yehowah, and even Satan proceeded to enter right among them. (**Job 1:6**)

[Question] Who had access to Yehowah God in heaven, and to all of the other angels and heavenly creations?

- 10· Smoother than butter are the words of his mouth, but his **heart** is disposed to fight. His words are softer than oil, but they are, drawn swords. (**Psalms 55:21**)

[Question] How does a man cover his true feelings, when his heart is not right with God, or his fellowman?

- 11· Then one of the twelve, the one called **Judas Iscariot**, went to the chief priests (**Matthew 26:14**)

[Question] Which one of Jesus' disciples went to the chief priests to betray Jesus?

- 12· Carefully watching, that no one may be deprived of the undeserved kindness of God, that no poisonous root may spring up and cause trouble, and that many may not be defiled by it. (**Hebrews 12:15**)

[Question] What did Paul warn anointed Christians not to let spring up among them?
