

John 13:21~ After saying these things, Jesus became troubled in spirit, and he bore witness and said; **Most truly I say to you, one of you will betray me.**

1· So after saying these things, and while they were still at the table, Jesus became troubled in spirit, and bore witness to them all; One of you will betray me!

[Question] How did Jesus now start to feel, and what did he tell his disciples?

2· While they were eating, he said; Truly I say to you, one of you will betray me. (Matthew 26:21)

[Question] When did Jesus tell all the disciples, that he was going to be betrayed?

3· And as they were reclining at the table and eating, Jesus said; Truly I say to you, one of you, who is eating with me, will betray me. (Mark 14:18)

[Question] What did Jesus tell his disciples, while they were eating the Passover meal together?

4· But, look! The hand of my betrayer is with me at the table. (Luke 22:21)

[Question] Whose hand did Jesus say was with him at the table, where they ate the Passover meal?

5· Jesus answered them; I chose you twelve, did I not? Yet one of you is a slanderer. (John 6:70)

[Question] What did Jesus state, despite the fact that he had selected all twelve apostles?

6· Men, brothers, it was necessary for the scripture to be fulfilled, which the Holy Spirit spoke beforehand by David's mouth, about Judas, who became a guide to those who arrested Jesus. (Acts of Apostles 1:16)

[Question] Who originally prophesied, that one of the Messiah's disciples would betray him, and who bore witness to this on Pentecost?

7· Jesus, therefore, when he saw her weeping, and the Jews that came with her weeping, groaned in the spirit and

became troubled. (John 11:33)

[Question] How did Jesus feel also when Lazarus died, and many were there mourning for him?
