John 13:26~ Therefore Jesus answered; It is that one to whom I shall give the morsel that I dip. And so, having dipped the morsel, he took and gave it to Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot.

1. So rather than alert all present, to who it was, he said, that it was the one to whom he would give the morsel he would dip. So he immediately dipped the morsel of food in the common bowl, and handed it to Judas, the son of Simon Iscariot.

[Question] What did Jesus tell John in answer, and why was he so discreet about this?

[Question] What did Jesus then do, and who did he give the morsel of food to?

2. In reply he said; He that dips his hand with me in the bowl, is the one that will betray me. (Matthew 26:23)

[Question] Who did Jesus tell them was the betrayer?

3. Also, the man at peace with me, in whom I trusted, who was eating my bread, has magnified his heel against me. (Psalms 41:9)

[Question] How did the Psalms written by King David foretell this betrayal?
