John 13:28~ However, none of those reclining at the table knew for what purpose he said this to him.

1. Yet at the time none of those reclining at the table, knew for what purpose Jesus had said this to Judas. Jesus did things thus, so that no one would try to stop Judas, form completing the task he was doing, for it had to take place.

[Question] Did any of the others know why Jesus dismissed Judas Iscariot, at the time it happened?

[Question] Why then, did Jesus do these things so discreetly, for what might have happened, if he made it more obvious?
