John 13:29~ Some, in fact, were imagining, since Judas was holding the money box, that Jesus was telling him; Buy what things we need for the festival, or, that he should give something to the poor.

1. Some of them were in fact imagining, that because Judas held the money box, that Jesus was telling him to buy something that they needed for the festival, or that he should go and make a gift to the poor. They did not know at the time, why he had been dismissed.

[Question] What did some of his disciples then imagine, that Jesus was telling Judas Iscariot?

2' He said this, though, not because he was concerned about the poor, but because he was a thief and had the money box and used to carry off the monies put in it. (John 12:6)

[Question] Why had Judas Iscariot earlier complained, about the use of the costly perfumed oil?

3. Jesus said to him; If you want to be perfect, go sell your belongings and give to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven, and come be my follower. (Matthew 19:21)

[Question] What did Jesus tell a man would make him perfect in his godly devotion, and what did he then invite the man to do?

4. But Judas Iscariot, one of his disciples, who was about to betray him, said. (John 12:4)

[Question] Who was it that earlier complained, about the use of the costly perfumed oil?
