

**John 13:3~** He, knowing that the Father had given all things into his hands, and that he came forth from God, and was going to God.

- 1· Jesus then knew, that he had come forth from God, and was going to God as soon as he died. Also he knew, that the Father had given all things in heaven and on earth into his hands, because of his loyalty and faithfulness unto death.

**[Question]** What did Jesus know was his destiny upon dying faithful on earth, and why would he be granted the honor of a resurrection?

- 2· All things have been delivered to me by my Father, and no one fully knows the Son, but the Father, neither does anyone fully know the Father, but the Son, and anyone, to whom the Son is willing to reveal him. (**Matthew 11:27**)

**[Question]** What things have been delivered to Jesus Christ by Yehowah God, and who knows his Son the best?

- 3· Therefore let all the house of Israel know for a certainty, that God made him both Lord and Christ, this Jesus, whom you impaled. (**Acts of Apostles 2:36**)

**[Question]** What should all the house of Israel know about Jesus Christ, for what has Yehowah God made him?

- 4· For God, subjected all things under his feet. But when he says, that all things have been subjected, it is evident that it is with the exception, of the one who subjected all things to him. (**1 Corinthians 15:27**)

**[Question]** What things have been subjected under Christ's feet?

- 5· All things you subjected under his feet. For in that he subjected all things to him, God left nothing that is not subject to him. Now, though, we do not yet see all things in subjection to him. (**Hebrews 2:8**)

**[Question]** What has God left, that is not now subject to Jesus Christ?

**[Question]** Do we presently though, see all things in subjection to Jesus Christ?

- 6· I came out from the Father and have come into the world. Further, I am leaving the world, and am going my way to the Father. (**John 16:28**)

**[Question]** Where did Jesus come forth from, and where did he return to after his death?

- 7· In answer Jesus said to them; Even if I do bear witness about myself, my witness is true, because I know where I **came** from, and where I am **going**. But you do not know where I **came** from, and where I am **going**. (**John 8:14**)

**[Question]** Why was the witness Jesus bore about himself true, for what did he know, that others did not know?

- 8· Jesus said to them; If **God** were your **Father**, you would love me, for from **God** I **came** forth, and am here. Neither have I come of my own initiative at all, but that One sent me forth. (**John 8:42**)

**[Question]** What did Jesus tell his listeners, that he came forth from, and so how should others feel about Jesus Christ?

- 9· But now I am **going** to him that sent me, and yet not one of you asks me; Where are you going? (**John 16:5**)

**[Question]** Where did Jesus tell his disciples, on the night of the Memorial, that he was going back to?

- 10· Jesus, therefore, knowing all the **things** coming upon him, went forth and said to them; Whom are you looking for? (**John 18:4**)

**[Question]** Who readily identified himself, to the angry mob that came out to arrest him in Gethsemane?
