

John 13:31~ Hence when he had gone out, Jesus said; Now the Son of man is glorified, and God is glorified in connection with him.¹

Footnote: Or, by means of him

1· So when Judas had left, Jesus remarked, that now the Son Of Man was glorified, and God also was glorified in connection with him. For having this uncleanness removed, glorified both Jesus and his father Yehowah God.

[Question] Why did Jesus now say that he was glorified, and who also was glorified in connection with Jesus?

[Question] For what were they able to identify and remove before the fact, leaving his disciples in what condition?

2· But Jesus answered them, saying; The hour has come for the Son of man to be glorified. (John 12:23)

[Question] What hour did Jesus earlier state was at hand?

3· Also, whatever it is that you ask in my name, I will do this, in order, that the Father may be glorified in connection with the Son. (John 14:13)

[Question] What did Jesus promise to his disciples that he would see to it, if his disciples asked it in his name?

4· Then Moses said to Aaron; This is what Yehowah has spoken, saying; Among those near to me let, me be sanctified, and before the face of all the people, let me be glorified. And Aaron kept silent. (Leviticus 10:3)

[Question] What did Yehowah God demand of Moses and Aaron, from those who were close to him?

5· I have glorified you on the earth, having finished the work you have given me to do. (John 17:4)

[Question] How did Jesus fulfilling the work of living out Bible prophecies, glorify Yehowah God?
