John 13:32~ And God will himself glorify him, and he will glorify him immediately.

1. Then Jesus revealed, that God himself would glorify his son, and would do so immediately, for in just three short days, he would resurrect him to life eternal.

[Question] What did Jesus then reveal was going to happen immediately, and what does immediately mean, within this context?

2. However, he said this concerning the spirit, which those who put faith in him, were about to receive, for as yet there was no spirit, because Jesus had not yet been glorified. (John 7:39)

[Question] What did Jesus give to his disciples after he had been glorified, by being raised from the dead?

3. Jesus spoke these things, and, raising his eyes to heaven, he said; Father, the hour has come. Glorify your son, that your son may glorify you. (John 17:1)

[Question] What did Jesus say later that night in prayer to his Father, for what hour of test was immediately ahead of Jesus?

4. Jesus answered; If I glorify myself, my glory is nothing. It is my Father that glorifies me, he, who you say, is your God. (John 8:54)

[Question] What did Jesus show would not necessarily glorify himself, but who did he say did glorify him?

5. But Jesus answered them, saying; The hour has come for the Son of man to be glorified. (John 12:23)

[Question] What hour did Jesus say later that same night, was fast approaching?
