

John 13:34~ I am giving you a new commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you, that you also love one another.

1· So then, Jesus gave them a new commandment. Now the commandment to love one another was not new, for the whole focus of the Law Covenant was to love one's neighbor as oneself, and to love God with all ones heart, spirit, and active force. Yet the degree of this love is what was new, they were to love one another, in the same manner that he had loved them, even giving one's life in one another's behalf.

[Question] What new commandment did Jesus now give to his disciples, and what was new about it?

2· Just as the Father has loved me and I have loved you, remain in my love. (John 15:9)

[Question] How did Jesus love his disciples, and where did he learn to love like this?

3· And go on walking in love, just as the Christ also loved you, and delivered himself up for you as an offering, and a sacrifice to God, for a sweet-smelling odor. (Ephesians 5:2)

[Question] How does the apostle Paul encourage anointed Christians to walk, and after whose example?

4· You must not take vengeance nor have a grudge against the sons of your people, and you must love your fellow as yourself. I am Yehowah. (Leviticus 19:18)

[Question] What should anointed Christians not hold toward one another, or toward anyone?

5· This is my commandment, that you love one another, just as I have loved you. (John 15:12)

[Question] What is Jesus first commandment, and how must we love one another?

6· However, with reference to brotherly love, you do not need us to be writing you, for you yourselves are taught by God, to love one another. (1 Thessalonians 4:9)

[Question] What did Paul show was the force motivating anointed Christians to love one another?

- 7· If, now, you practice carrying out the kingly Law according to the scripture: You must **love** your neighbor as yourself, you are doing quite well. (**James 2:8**)

[Question] What Law did James show, that anointed Christians must follow?

- 8· Now that you **have** purified your souls by your obedience to the truth, with unhypocritical brotherly affection as the result, **love** one another intensely from the heart. (**1 Peter 1:22**)

[Question] How do anointed Christians purify their souls, and what then results from having the right thinking, and heart motivations?

- 9· We know we **have** passed over from death to life, because we **love** the brothers. He who does not **love** remains in death. (**1 John 3:14**)

[Question] How do anointed Christians know, that they have passed over from death to life?

[Question] What does anyone not loving his fellowman remain in?

- 10· If you **love** me, you will observe my **commandments**. (**John 14:15**)

[Question] What did Jesus show, that men who loved him, would also do in proof of that love?

- 11· If you observe my **commandments**, you will remain in my **love**, just as I **have** observed the **commandments** of the Father, and remain in his **love**. (**John 15:10**)

[Question] How can anointed Christians remain in Christ's love, for how did Christ remain in his Father's love?

- 12· These things I command you, that you **love** one another. (**John 15:17**)

[Question] What did Jesus command his disciples many times?

- 13· To those without Law I became as without Law, although I am not without Law toward God, but under Law toward Christ, that I might gain those without Law. (**1 Corinthians 9:21**)

[Question] How did Paul act around men, who were themselves under Law, and why so?

- 14· **Go on carrying the burdens of one another, and thus fulfill the Law of the Christ. (Galatians 6:2)**

[Question] What should anointed Christians willingly carry for one another, and what will this fulfill?

- 15· **Has at the end of these days spoken to us by means of a Son, whom he appointed heir of all things, and through whom he made the systems of things. (Hebrews 1:2)**

[Question] Who has Yehowah God appointed to become the heir of all things in creation, and why?

- 16· **Beloved ones, I am writing you, not a new commandment, but an old commandment which you have had from the beginning. This old commandment, is the word which you heard. (1 John 2:7)**

[Question] How did John in his second letter, show that this commandment of Jesus was an old commandment for anointed Christians?

- 17· **For this is the message which you have heard from the beginning, that we should have love for one another. (1 John 3:11)**

[Question] What message have anointed Christians heard from the beginning?

- 18· **Indeed, this is his commandment, that we have faith in the name of his Son Jesus Christ, and be loving one another, just as he gave us commandment. (1 John 3:23)**

[Question] What commandment do anointed Christians have from Yehowah God, through Christ?

- 19· **And this commandment we have from him, that the one who loves God, should be loving his brother also. (1 John 4:21)**

[Question] What must the one stating that he loves God, also be loving, or else he is a liar?

- 20· **So now I request you, lady, as a person writing you, not a**

new commandment, but one which we had from the beginning, that we love one another. (2 John 1:5)

[Question] What commandment did John write to the lady about, and how long have we had this commandment?
