

John 13:36~ **Simon Peter said to him; Lord, where are you going? Jesus answered; Where I am going you cannot follow me now, but you will follow afterwards.**

- 1· **So Peter asked Jesus where he was going. Jesus then answered, that where he was going they could not follow at present, but later, they would follow him there.**

[Question] What question did Peter then ask of Jesus, and how did Jesus reply?

- 2· **Also, if I go my way and prepare a place for you, I **am** coming again, and **will** receive you home to myself, that where I **anymore**, you also may be. (John 14:3)**

[Question] Why was Jesus going away to heaven, and what did he promise to make ready for them there, and to do in the future?

- 3· **Knowing as I do that the putting off of my tabernacle is soon to be, just as also our Lord **Jesus** Christ signified to me. (2 Peter 1:14)**

[Question] What did Peter know was approaching for him, as he became an old man?

- 4· **These are the ones that did not defile themselves with women, in fact, they are virgins. These are the ones that keep following the Lamb no matter where he goes. These were bought from among mankind as firstfruits to God and to the Lamb. (Revelation 14:4)**

[Question] What man alone on earth, do anointed Christians follow faithfully, and what does this make them, since they are not yet married to Christ while still in the flesh?

- 5· **Thomas **said** to him; **Lord**, we do not know where you are **going**. How do we know the way? (John 14:5)**

[Question] What did Thomas also remark, showing that he did not understand what Jesus had said?
