- 1· **So Peter, loving Jesus, and wanting to follow him now, asked, why he could not follow him at present. Then he stated adamantly, that he was willing to surrender his soul in Christ's behalf.**

[Question] Why did Peter now ask, why he could not follow Jesus at present?

[Question] What did he say that he was willing to do, to follow after Jesus?

- 2· **But Peter, in answer, **said** to him; Although all the others are stumbled in connection with you, never **will** I be stumbled! (**Matthew 26:33**)**

[Question] How did Peter arrogantly state his own self-confidence, in his own will and ability, to faithfully follow Jesus?

- 3· **But Peter **said** to him; Even if all the others are stumbled, yet I **will** not be. (**Mark 14:29**)**

[Question] What did Peter show he was willing to do, beyond all the others?

- 4· **Then he **said** to him; **Lord**, I am ready to go with you both into prison, and into death. (**Luke 22:33**)**

[Question] What did Peter state that he was willing to do right along with Jesus if necessary?
